County OKs system to nab toll violators

County officials want bridge toll violators stopped and agreed today to spend \$1.86 million for a system to identify violators and mail them a citation.

A Violation Enforcement System will be installed all three Lee County toll locations. It uses cameras mounted in the toll lanes to identify violators by taking a picture of their license plate. The information is transmitted to a toll enforcement officer at the LeeWay Service Center.

Then the system further distinguishes whether a warning letter or uniform traffic citation will be issued to the registered owner of the vehicle.

County commissioners gave the contract to install the \$1.86 million system to VESystems Corporation today.

Running through bridge tolls without paying has been a problem with Lee County's toll facilities since they were installed, Commissioner John Albion said at today's meeting.

"I think we are far enough along now that this is needed," Albion said.
